

Subject: Appraisal webinar scheduled for 2 p.m. April 24

The West Virginia Housing Institute Inc., and the Virginia Manufactured and Modular Housing Association want to make sure that none of you are taken by surprise when new appraisal requirements for some manufactured homes come into effect on July 18 under the federal Dodd-Frank Act.

This is the first of two webinars Dick will offer on our behalf on this subject so if you miss the first, you can catch the second, which is not yet scheduled.
