#### Four contractor licenses issued by State Board

CHARLESTON – Four manufactured housing contractors were licensed Thursday by the state board that oversees the factory-built housing industry in West Virginia.

Issued licenses by the Manufactured Housing Construction and Safety Standards Board were: Advantage Air Inc. of Davy; In a Flash Plumbing Heating & AC, LLC, of Anmoore; Terry R. Brumfield, doing business as HGR Trucking, of Harts; and Barefoot Transportation Inc., doing business as Frederick's Dirt Works of Buckhannon.

The board recommended payment from the recovery fund to repair the home of Roger Dale Scott of Delbarton. The submission goes to the recovery fund, which was created by the industry to cover repairs to work left incomplete when a contractor goes out of business. The contractor was Brumfield Toting of West Hamlin.

Deputy Labor Commissioner Mitch Woodrum told the board the recovery fund totals \$1.49 million.

The board will meet again in July to approve annual licensing requests.
