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Two submissions to recovery fund approved

CHARLESTON -- The state board that regulates the factory-built housing industry in West Virginia agreed Wednesday to correct defects in two manufactured homes through payments from a fund voluntarily established by the industry to meet those problems.

The board unanimously approved payments from the Division of Labor's recovery fund for ventilation problems in homes owned by Frank and Cindy Hook of Roanoke, W.Va., and Debbie Junkins of Morgantown.

The homes had been manufactured by Fleetwood Homes of Pennsylvania, a company that has gone out of business. The recovery fund was created by the industry to complete unfinished work or fix errors in homes when a manufacturer had ceased operations before the homes were properly installed.
