State Board issues three contractor licenses

CHARLESTON -- Contractor licenses have been issued to three companies by the board that regulates the manufactured housing industry in West Virginia.

The West Virginia Manufactured Housing Construction and Safety Standards Board issued the licenses to High Standards WVAC & Supply Inc. of Bunker Hill, Jefferson County; Stone Front Homes LLC of Corning, Ohio; and Orange Brothers Masonry of Bedford, Va.

Seventeen companies, including three retail centers, were fined \$50 or \$25 for not submitting a quarterly report concerning business they conducted during the final quarter of 2014.

Board Chairman and Deputy Labor Commissioner Mitch Woodrum reported to the State Board on May 21 that the industry's voluntary recovery fund to help consumers has a total of \$1.52 million. The State Board approved an application to the recovery fund on behalf of Brian Adkins of Chapmanville, Logan County.

The State Board is scheduled to meet again at 10 a.m. July 23 in Charleston.
