New retailer approved for Princeton; two Ohio companies relicensed

CHARLESTON -- State manufactured housing regulators approved a license for a new manufacturing housing sales center in southern West Virginia on Tuesday and two reapplications from retailers in Ohio.

Paragon, LLC, of Princeton will be the newest manufactured housing retailer in the state after it was approved by the West Virginia Manufactured Housing Construction and Safety Standards Board.

The State Board also approved licenses for longtime retailers Midwest Manufactured Homes LLC of Frazeyburg, Ohio; and Bob's Quality Homes Inc. of Belpre, Ohio.

A contractor license was issued by the State Board for L&L Mobile Home Transport of Thornton, Taylor County, a company located just east of Grafton.

The State Board approved the expenditure of money from the state recovery fund to fix the home of Jonathon Sumpter of Sandy Fork in Gilmer County. The fund was voluntarily created by the industry to repair homes whose work was not completed when the manufacturer ceased doing business.
